#### **Local Minimum Wage Laws Prohibited in Colorado**

Adjustments to the state minimum wage are prohibited by statute in the Minimum Wage Law. The legislature declared minimum wages to be a statewide concern and prohibits local governments from enacting laws to raise the minimum wage within their jurisdictions either through its legislative powers or through initiative or referendum. See CRS 8-6-101.
